

PROVIDER CURRICULUM REVIEW EXPENSE

(a) - Background: CTEC contracts for provider curriculum review with independent outside education specialists. The cost of this review represents a significant part of CTEC's annual budget. The following provider fees are imposed to offset a portion of these costs and apply to new applicants, already approved providers due for a periodic review, and providers requesting a change in approval status. Change in approval status includes: 1) providers approved to offer continuing education courses and are requesting approval to offer qualifying education courses; and, 2) providers approved to offer qualifying education courses that are requesting approval to offer continuing education courses. (Reference: CTEC Policy CP02 – CTEC Curriculum Provider Application).

(b) - Initial Curriculum Review Costs

- (1) Qualifying Education Applicants: Providers applying to obtain CTEC approval to offer qualifying education must submit \$1,500 with their initial application packet.
- **(2) Continuing Education Applicants:** Providers applying to obtain CTEC approval to offer continuing education must submit \$600 with their initial application packet.
- (3) Public Universities and Colleges are exempt from submitting provider curriculum review fees.
- (c) Periodic Review Costs
 - (1) Qualifying Education Applicants: Providers required to submit a QE course for periodic review to extend their CTEC approval, must submit \$1,000 with their application packet.
 - (2) Continuing Education Applicants: Providers required to submit a CE course for periodic review to extend their CTEC approval, must submit \$600 with their application packet.
 - (3) Public Universities and Colleges are exempt from submitting periodic review fees.
- (d) Incomplete Submissions Incomplete provider submissions are subject to an administrative fee of \$250, per the provisions of CP02 and CP14. This does not apply to public universities and colleges.
- (e) Subsequent Curriculum Review Costs If curriculum approval is not attained during the initial curriculum review, additional fees will be assessed as indicated in CP14.
